## MARKET INSIGHTS

### MAINLAND CHINA

- China has the most active digital investment and start-up ecosystem in the world, and has emerged as the world's largest investor in fintech. **Shanghai** is China's largest and most developed financial and business hub. The city has a high concentration of multinational corporations, innovation clusters, tech incubators and China's largest concentration of blockchain-related start-ups and labs, in addition to favourable government policies.
- The Chinese blockchain ecosystem is rapidly growing. According to China's Ministry of Industry and Information Technology's (MIIT) recent [whitepaper](#), as at the end of March 2018 there was a total of 456 blockchain companies in China. Data from the World Intellectual Property Organization reveals **China was the largest blockchain patent filer in the world in 2017**, with China contributing 225 international blockchain patent applications, followed by the USA with 91 filings and Australia with 13.
- China's State Council has endorsed blockchain technology as part of an **Information Technology Reformation Strategy in China's 13th Five-year Economic Development Plan (2016-2020)** with President Xi Jinping calling the technology a "breakthrough application" in May 2018. In fact throughout 2018, Chinese local government authorities have demonstrated a pro-blockchain attitude, funding multi-billion dollar initiatives and blockchain-based networks. This has drawn increasing capital including:
  - April 2018: Hangzhou Municipal government launched a US\$1.6 billion Global Blockchain Innovation Fund to finance emerging blockchain startups and announced a new subsidy policy of generous resettlement and R&D funding packages to attract blockchain talent and development teams.
  - May 2018: The largest cryptocurrency exchange in Asia, Huobi announced plans to build a "Global Cultural and Creative Blockchain Lab" on Hainan Island. This coincides with Huobi's launch of a US\$1 billion dollar fund to invest in blockchain globally.
  - March 2018: The Economic, Trade and Information Commission of Shenzhen announced qualified blockchain projects would be eligible for up to RMB 2 million in local government R&D funding packages.
  - December 2017: Guangdong Pilot Free Trade Zone rolled out its first blockchain policy, adding RMB 200 million to its annual government budget to attract blockchain entrepreneurs.

## TAIWAN

- Taiwan is a technology-based economy in the global supply chain, underpinned by its world-leading ICT/semiconductor industry. It is a well-established and well-regulated market with strong IP protection to position itself at the forefront of industrial innovation. Taiwan has attracted technology giants including 47 MNCs to set up 65 R&D centres, including Google, Microsoft, IBM, Sony, ARM, Dell, Corning, working on breakthrough across AI, blockchain technology, cloud computing and other technologies.
- Blockchain is fast becoming a new cornerstone of Taiwan's industrial innovation. Successful blockchain industry leaders in Taiwan include: currency exchange (Maicoin, BitoEx), health records (DTCO), digital identity (IDGO), food safety and travel (Owlting), music distribution (Soundscape) and crypto hardware wallet (CoolBitx). The world's largest contract electronics manufacture, Foxconn Technology Group, is already manufacturing the world's first blockchain smartphone.
- Financial institutions, businesses and investors are keen to adopt the latest blockchain technology to solve their pain points, increase business efficiency, and reduce cost and risks. Besides cross-sectors solutions, blockchain technology in Taiwan also supports an active crypto market. A number of international high profile developers, including Vitalik Buterin, co-founder of Ethereum, have visited Taiwan multiple times to seek opportunities.
- The blockchain industry in Taiwan enjoys strong support from policy makers. Taiwanese legislators recently formed the "Taiwan Parliamentary Coalition for Blockchain (TPCB)" to advocate further development of blockchain technologies. In addition, the newly established "Taiwan Crypto Blockchain Self-Regulatory Organization (TCBSRO)" was initiated by a high-profile legislator. Taiwan also implemented a fintech regulatory sandbox with the world's longest potential experimentation period (3 years).

## MISSION SUMMARY
